#### Continue from last month ~ What God accomplished exceeds all we can think of

Prospering the Lord's Gospel: The three cities have seen a fast increase in Chinese population. Most of the church coworkers are engaged in retail and wholesale of household items, restaurants, Chinese school, etc. Facing economic downturn, they continue to hold fast to their faith, earnestly sharing the Gospel and bear witnesses!

Not stopping to gather: Even in lacking a regular pastor and from their limits rented gathering place, brothers and sisters strive to absorb their spiritual nutrients. They study the Bible, listen to sermons reading spiritual online, materials, hosting teams to learn and care for each other, organize a choir, and diligently teach the next generation.

**Brother Lin**: That night, our team members, even Christine Pi, heard the most from him for the first time.

Yue-Jin: "My heart is full of thanksgiving. I am a villager, not even finished with second grade and cannot speak Mandarin well, I've always been shy, lack self-confidence, and not dare to share among people." After our encouragement and praying, she gave her witness that Sunday!

Mr. Li: We were praying to God for a local brother to act in a skit. Unbelievably, he showed up the first night. And he was such a young and funny brother. No one even came close to play

that role!

Christine Pi: Because of overfatigue, Christine has been coughing from the beginning of the trip, finding it difficult to speak. And she's scheduled to preach the very first afternoon after we arrived in Belo Horizonte. The result: her voice cleared up, the teaching was powerful, and her testimony touched many people!

The establishment of the Youth Fellowship in Belo Horizonte: God wants to bless this land and raise up these children to prosper the Gospel!

### **Enjoyed the joy and peace from God's presence**

Every STM member took up several roles, having to be responsible, self-initiated, flexible, compliment each other's work. God looked after our health and safety and our families so that we lack nothing. May God help every local coworker of the church even more, enabling a united love in Christ.

## Special workshop used by God

Christine Pi knows the needs of the local Chinese churches, selecting "Emotion Management" as the theme. In Salvador, we made it to the World Cup, with lots of noises all around. In Recife, we had enough time and strength for the challenge. In Belo Horizonte, even after three nights of continuous workshops, no one wanted to leave. Instead, they continued to play games, sing hymns in response, and finally prayers after

reluctantly went home.

During the workshops held in three places and nine sessions, I thank God for blessing me to have new opportunities to learn from Him, resting my burdens on Him, being obedient to the Holy Spirit's leading, and sharing with others in a relaxed and joyful way. I also received support and encouragement from many feedbacks.

We even strolled on the Recife seashore, known as the Venice of South America.

#### A blessed journey

During the STM, I daily went near God, asking for His mercy for my weakened body:

Deaf and blind—lost the ability of the language. I only learned "good morning" and "thank you" in Portuguese. In asking for hot water and handling airconditioning matters with the hotel, I had to use Google translate to manage.

**Rotten leg**—Other than where we were staying, we couldn't go anywhere else!
