Below are several major needs in the fields CIM has in the coming year:

• A strategy targeting churches that do not yet have fulltime pastors. For churches that lack local ministers who are willing to commit full-time, the approach is to train lay people to lead brothers and sisters—actively plan how to train local coworkers and systematically provide discipleship, training in order to strengthen their foundational beliefs, guide them in basic church administration, and provide Bible study resource materials. The focus would be on equipping believers to learn how to read the Bible, participate in mission work, encourage brothers and sisters to enroll in seminaries and become pastors, and to go forward with church planting as a goal.

Alex and Nicole Ko are a perfect example. Under the training and encouragement of Rev. Douglas Wu in South Africa, Alex enrolled in a seminary in Taiwan in 2013. We hope more brothers and sisters are willing to boldly answer God's call and respond to His love in committing to be full-time missionaries.

• Development of ministry to the younger generation, using youth activities as the open door. The goal is to maximize the advantages young people have in terms of contact with local and foreign cultures. We would aim to use the new generation who can communicate in the local language as a base to continue the task of the Great Commission, striving forward, mindful of God's will, and be used by God to serve this generation. May God raise up more young people to have a burden for missions.

Believers nowadays, especially those who are in North America, have an advantage in terms of resources and opportunities more than ever before. We should use this advantage fully for the propagation of the Gospel. Queen Esther was reminded by her uncle Mordecai in Esther 4:14 that, "And who knows but that you have come to your royal position for such a time as this?" 2015 STM TRIPS PROMOTION

<u>Brazil</u> July 09 - Jul 24 July 16- August 02 <u>South Africa</u> July 10-17 Dec 30- Jan 11, 2016

<u>Ghana and Togo</u> Until the Ebola virus is under control, the dates for these STM trips will be announced accordingly.

PRAYER REQUESTS

- 1. Pray for Rev. Wu's complete healing. Pray also for supernatural strength for him and Whitney in their ministries. May the Lord grant grace as Douglas has to balance his schedule among the four churches in three cities.
- 2. Pray for New Light Christian Church of Chicago's STM trip to SA in December, for good rapport among the team members, good health, and safe journey.
- 3. Pray for South Africa's newly published immigration bill. Ask for the Lord for His righteousness and mercy, minimizing the effect of this on the Chinese immigrants there. This new bill has also affected missionaries in their application for temporary visas. Most of those who asked to have their visas be extended have been denied. Ask the Lord to open a door.
- 4. Please intercede for the resubmission of Pretoria Chinese Church registration process. Ask the Lord to prepare His workers and to make up with the documents of two church members.
- 5. There is urgent and immediate need in the mission fields among the Chinese in South Africa and Brazil. Pray earnestly for the God of harvest to send forth His workers to reap the harvest.
- 6. Ask the Lord to grant rest to the teachers and students at Happy Kids and Happy Teens ministries as they begin their December to early January break so that they will be refreshed. Pray also for the preparation in planning for the curriculum of summer program and the new school year.
- 7. Ask that the Lord will open the way for the teachers at Happy Teens to be able to assist the students to successfully pass the school entrance exams in Brazil.
- 8. Intercede for the brothers and sisters at the church in Belo Horizonte, Brazil, to put their dedication for Bible study and other ministries into practice.
- 9. Pray for the brothers and sisters in Salvador, Brazil, to take more opportunity to read the Bible and to learn how to seek the Lord.
- 10. Rev. Lucio of the church in Belo has agreed to serve there. Ask the Lord to grant favor to the brothers and sisters there that they may have a heart to learn and to know Him more.

- 11. Please pray for the church in Belo Horizonte for their hope to expand through cell groups. Also ask that the extension of their ministries will be according to God's will.
- 12. Ask the Lord to raise up French-speaking coworkers to join in the ministries in Togo.
- 13. Please intercede for the villages that have been affected by the Ebola virus and for our coworkers in Ghana, asking for wisdom, love, and strength that can only come from Christ.
- 14. Ask the Lord to abundantly provide the financial needs of CIM's various departments.
- 15. Mrs. Christine Pi's had just received laser treatment on her right eye. Please ask the Lord to grant blessing so that the effect of the result will present itself. Pray also for safety in all her going out and coming in.
- 16. Mrs. Pi has been invited to speak at a special workshop at the CMC (Chinese Missions Convention) West Coast 2014 conference December 31 to January 3. Ask that the Lord will use her as a channel of movement so to enable her to clearly and simply share with the attendees of what she receives from Him. CIM's board members will also participate in hosting a booth, hoping to share with all our ministries. Your prayers are greatly coveted.
