During the past 20 years, PECCC experienced many difficulties: the late Rev. Clarence Pi's sudden passing; Pastor Chi Liu's leaving the field and returning to the U.S. due to serious illness; Rev. Douglas Wu's returning to Taiwan for treatment of his severe Hepatitis condition etc. God did not forget them. Through the mountains and valleys, He added to them strength and opened their vision, allowing them to focus their attention on the new community, pioneered bluecollar Gospel ministry, and later on established the FuQing Bible study group and church. There is plan to search for new opportunities in Johannesburg next year, forging forward a new milestone. There is also the hope to go from serving the Chinese as the foundation and step out to pursue crosscultural ministries to serve the South Africans.
