Many new Chinese immigrants in Brazil send their kids back to China to be raised by the grandparents or relatives while they struggle to start a new life. The kids would return to Brazil when they reach teenage, as the parents achieve a more stable living. The family reunion should be a joyous event for the youths, but instead they experience much frustration. It is hard to call “strangers” they have not seen for so long as Mom and Dad, and in school they couldn’t understand the language. Many lose their directions amid the struggles and leave school, ending up helping in the family store or getting a low paying job. Having no goal in life and no one to talk to about their future, they gradually lose their drive in life. How do we guide those “Problem Youths” and console their feeling of being shortchanged by life? After missing the window for schooling, they may not have many choices in life. Their goal would be to make money but without any vision for a brighter future. If we don’t share the gospel with them between ages of 13 and 18, it would be much harder later. Are you willing to join this ministry? Do you want

to invest on those youths so they could be part of God’s family? We would like to invite you to join CIM at the Sao Paulo youth retreat on March 2, 2019. Together we would lead the youths to know and accept Jesus, so they can receive God’s grace and enjoy a more meaningful life!

In general, to make money seems to be the only goal for the Chinese immigrants. They don’t have much education so their employment opportunities are limited. Most run retail stores involving the whole family. Recently the government shut down a warehouse and confiscated all the merchandise under the allegation of unlawful activity. It was a devastating loss for the immigrants who constantly live in fear. Who can help them escape their plight in darkness and into a bright future?

The only Chinese church in the city doesn’t have a pastor, so the congregation has Bible studies on Sundays and not sermons. They asked God to send a missionary pastor because they hunger for the spiritual blessing. May God revive the church, as well as each brother and sister, so they can love and

serve God more.

The CIM STM teams not only preach the gospel to new Chinese immigrants, but also equip and disciple brothers and sisters to walk with God. According to the Bible, man not only needs to work for his current life but must also prepare for his eternal life. We want the Chinese immigrants know there is a God who can be their help in this world.

When one mentions Brazil most think of soccer, coffee, and the statue of Jesus the Redeemer, which gazes at Rio de Janeiro from a hilltop. Tens of thousands of tourists flock to admire this grandiose statue. It looks over the whole city, which is actually the capital of murders and crimes in Brazil. Jesus, with his open hands, welcomes all sinners with his love, which is the Good News, so all whoever believes in him has eternal life!
