Douglas Family Prayer Letter from South Africa

01.Jun, 2012

Brother-in-Christ Tianen Lin of Rustenburg is in need of your prayers. His second vertebra was injured during a car collision with a Kudu on April 18, 2012. After the paramedics sent him to a hospital emergency, he started to puke non-stop. Though his symptoms were diagnosed later as a result of inhaling food particles into his lung, the doctor did not suspect the real cause at the time of admission. He coughed so hard that the radiologist was not able to take his CT scan. So the doctor sedated him, and he was out of conscience for 9 days. Not till his health condition turned critical, the doctors finally discovered that he had contracted pneumonia! They sent Brother Lin to ICU immediately where he stayed for 38 days, costing him around \$130,000. Without noticeable improvement, family members transferred Tianen to the best hospital in Pretoria on May 26 by putting down \$150,000 deposit in advance. His lung was seriously infected by then, doctors ordered a mandatory surgery for him. However, Tianen has been ill for too long, and his body is too frail. Having a lung surgery is too much of a risk for him. Nevertheless, he is scheduled on June 5. We pray that he'll be stronger by then to withstand the operation. We also pray that his family will be able to accept the fact that their dear one will be operated.

On May 7, Brother Tianen's family asked me to help transfer him to a different hospital. To ensure the process I consulted our neighbor, Dr. Klooster, a retired physician. He recommended Dr. A and told me that Dr. A works at the best hospital in town. Two days after their initial request, Tianen's family decided not to move him! On May 10, they thought of transferring again. This time, Dr. A requested the family to make a firm decision. On May 13, the family confirmed that they preferred staying for Tianen was getting better. On May 22, family members saw no signs of recovery, Tianen was getting skinner and skinner by the day, trying a different hospital became paramount. However, Dr. A had declined their request. Dr. B also refused on the next day. Contacting Dr. C was of no avail, either. Cloud of depression hovered over us as if Tianen received his death sentence. Out of desperation I approached Dr. Klooster again. Seek Dr. A's help, he recommended, for he is a righteous man. So I did. Dr. A told me to go home and pray. I approached Dr. D again, he told me to wait for his call. After half-day waiting, Dr. D replied, if the family members understand the risk, Tianen may be admitted.

Praying for Tianen was no easy matter for me because Brother Ong's experience haunted me. I distinctly remembered September 18, 2007, few days before I departed for deputation in the U. S., Ong was shot. He later suffered as a vegetable for years and finally died. How "little faith" I was, fearful of repeating history upon my dear brother for my plan is to go for a threeweek deputation next week. Romans 8:5-6 says, "Those who live according to the flesh have their minds set on what the flesh desires; but those who live in accordance with the Spirit have their minds set on what the Spirit desires. 6 The mind governed by the flesh is death, but the mind governed by the Spirit is life and peace." Oh, Lord, please forgive me and govern my mind, so that I may have life and peace. I know that "in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose."(Romans 8:28).
