God's words are more precious than gold, than much pure gold. They are sweeter than honey, than honey from the honeycomb. I had the privilege of reading 5 chapters of Bible a day for the last 19 years. Starting this month, it'll be my 23rd time to read Genesis. As Psalm 119:105 says, "Your word is a lamp for my feet, a light on my path." May God continue to grant me strength so that I may serve him according to His will.

Exodus 15:11, "Who among the gods is like you, Lord? Who is like you— majestic in holiness, awesome in glory, working wonders?" On September 14, Brother Ti-anen Lin was finally discharged from the hospital after 150 days of medical treatment! It was like a miracle watching him walking out the institution. Ti-anen's relatives were overjoyed. His aunt commented that he seemed to resurrect from death. After I returned home that night, Whitney and I reviewed God's grace and sovereignty. On November 1998, Rev. Clarence Pi went home to be with the Lord; on September 2007, XiaXing Weng was shot, became a vegetable after spending 1,000,000 Rand, and taken home in 2010. No matter what, God continued to watch over His church, care for the orphans and widows. He always keeps His promise. May we tell of His faithfulness and redemption to our children, and they will pass on the message from generation to generation.

PECCC has 15 years of history. God has blessed His church and used her as a platform for other South African Chinese ministries. Nine years ago, we came in contact with local Fu-Qings. (Currently, there are about 350,000 Chinese in South Africa, one-third of them are Fu-Qings.) Six years ago, we started the first Fu-Qing fellowship due to differences in cultural backgrounds from other Chinese, types of professions, and work schedules. After 5 years of prayer and hard work, the Pretoria Fu-Qings clearly felt led in starting their own church. Four of their brothers , XueJin Lin, MingXiong Chen, ShuiWang Zheng, and BenShun Zheng are willing to serve as leaders. Thus, Pretoria Evangelical Fu-Qing Chinese Christian Church (PEFCCC) is officially founded under PECCC's blessings.

We can tell that God is guiding them step by step. We are even more excited that Brother Alex Ko has accepted PECCC's invitation to serve as a full-time staff. Whitney and I don't have much experience in training such staff; however, we're willing to learn with him. May the Holy Spirit be our guide and teacher. In regards to invite Brother Ko, I have a confession to make. Originally we gave him two months to decide. Towards the end of the deadline, when he made no indication of coming, I almost gave up. What happened was that Alex and his wife were very careful in following God's direction. They did not respond till the last day. Currently his plan is to pursuit seminary training next year, so our agreement is for him to serve as a full-time staff till the end of next June. May the Lord strengthen his heart as he serves God full-time. Genesis 22:4 "So Abraham called that place The Lord Will Provide. And to this day it is said, 'On the mountain of the Lord it will be provided'." I know that helping Alex will be a burden for me on top of many existing ministries of mine. However, the hope of glory gives me joy and strength to follow Him. May God's will be done.

About fourteen months ago, a Caucasian lady came and requested for a free copy of Chinese Bible. Due to scarcity of resources, I hesitated to part one of mine. However, she explained that the Bible was for her daughter Sarah's new Chinese boy friend. She also promised to study the Word with him. Facing such a determined mother, I reluctantly gave her one. Now, the young couple just got married last month. Hai-liang Wang, lady's son-in-law, accepted Jesus into his heart. They asked me to bless them at their wedding. The groom further told me that he finished reading the Old Testament Bible and is ready to read the New Testament! God works in wondrous ways.

God lead Youn-guang Chen, one of our Fu-Qing brothers, to Witbank. After he relocated there, he gathered a relative family of four for Bible studies. He also contacted three other families who go to a True Jesus Church. He invited me to go there in October. I can only entrust the matter to the Lord. Another brother of Fu-Qing Fellowship, Ting Zhang, moved to Krugersdorp. He reported to us that five of his family members plus four members of his uncle's family, a total of nine people, can form a Bible study group. I also brought the matter to the Lord. May He direct us.

Rev. Joel Herholdt had gone with the Lord. In 1980s, he was the chairman of Reform Presbyterian Church mission union who also participated in sending one billion Bibles to China. He started an outreach English class in his church and supported our church for 16 years. Revelations 14:13 "Then I heard a voice from heaven say, 'Write this: Blessed are the dead who die in the Lord from now on.' 'Yes,' says the Spirit, 'they will rest from their labor, for their deeds will follow them.'"

OMF started a prayer fellowship in South Africa. During most recent meeting, the fellowship is formally named SACON indicating her South African Chinese outreach networking nature. At his closing prayer, Akari Teichert, an OC missionary, prayed, "Have mercy on us, Lord. Grant us teachable hearts and passion to evangelize the Chinese. Help us to surrender to you and commit whole-heartedly to the South African Chinese ministries..." My heart was once more shaken by the Holy Spirit! May the Lord of many nations pour out that passion not only to the Caucasians but also to us, Chinese Christians, whether it's for Chinese ministries or for cross-cultural missions.
