Ephesians 4:11-12 "So Christ himself gave the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the pastors and teachers, to equip his people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up." We feel very privileged for the deputation opportunity in the U.S. As we prayerfully prepared for the trip, we noticed that "apostles," according to the Bible, are essential to healthy churches. To me, "apostles" means "missionaries." They are integral part to equip God's people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up. This passage reminds me of Elder Bai-Yi Chuang from CDTS and Elder Chris Chen from CCIC-NV who came for three weeks of equipping. During preparation time, I had a slight feeling of dejection because of a zero success rate. For the last 10 years, we've spoken to numerous churches during deputation, but no one was willing to give his/her life for the missions. Other words of discouragement also haunted me, "Why don't you give up? What a waste of words! No one will ever become missionaries!" As soon as I realized that these thoughts came from Satan, I prayed earnestly to God! Prayers allowed me to gain a deeper understanding of the importance of apostleship and missionaries.

I Corinthians 12:28-29 says, "And God has placed in the church first of all apostles, second prophets, third teachers, then miracles, then gifts of healing, of helping, of guidance, and of different kinds of tongues. Are all apostles? Are all prophets? Are all teachers? Do all work miracles?"

By God's design, missionaries are parts of the Body of Christ. Church send out missionaries because of His promise, such as in the case of church in Antioch and church in Jerusalem. Church of Philippi also commissioned Epaphroditus. After thinking through these Bible passages, I thank the Holy Spirit for showing God's truth to me and recognize Satan's scheme. Therefore we put on the full armor of God and embarked the trip with faith. May the LORD do great things through us! Jesus came to the earth for 33 years; Paul served faithfully for about 20 years, that's why he wrote in I Corinthians 4:9, "For it seems to me that God has put us apostles on display at the



end of the procession, like those condemned to die in the arena. We have been made a spectacle to the whole universe, to angels as well as to human beings."

God's ways are higher than our ways! After we arrived in Chicago, we met Rev. James Taylor on our first night at Living Water Evangelical Church. Both of us were invited to speak at their annual missions conference. Rev. Taylor was the main speaker and his' message was: $\lceil Go = \rangle$ Grow \rfloor : If you want to grow, you must go. I couldn't agree more with the theme thus urged the congregation to give their lives for the missions with all my strength.
