- Busy travel:2016 has been a busy year, with going back to Hong Kong for family reasons and being in Cambodia for our short annual term missions trip;
- Financial burden:although there are financial support for the missions team, it was still a huge burden;
- Tired wife: Debbie has been to two STM trips this year. When I talked to her about this trip for the first her "no" time. was understandable, yes, it is going to be really tired for her going on to a total five overseas trip in one year. But after prayers and different conversations with different

people, Debbie later decided to obey and join the team. And with that said. I decided to join, as I don't want to "miss out" the things that God wants us to see.

Here are a few notes and reflections that I have taken during the trip:

- 1) During the visitations, I saw a lot of brokenness in the families and the bondage of money on their lives. What is the reason for their "just a little bit more" thinking? Who are we really serving, and ultimately, what is the point of having a big and luxurious house?
- 2) We have visited some pretty dangerous places on visitation. Pastor Ching brought up a good reminder - Chinese can pretty much survive in every hardship and live in any corner of the world. Their will and
