Happy Kids is a kindergarten, and Happy Teens is a school for academic counseling. Happy Kids and Happy Teen's vision is to spread the Gospel to families through school-aged students. My serving experience over the years is even up to now, Jehovah God is still helping us.

"Twenty years ago, a seed fell to the ground and took root, grew branches and leaves, and is now thriving after being exposed to wind, rain, and sun; accumulating fruits. Its names: Happy Kids Academy, Happy Teens Center, and Happy Homeland.

Looking back 20 years ago, the late Rev Clarence Pi, the late CIM Director General, received a vision from God: to establish a school for Chinese children based on the Christian background, and to spread the Gospel into the families through the students.

I got to know CIM's ministry in Brazil through participation in this ministry. Thank you to CIM for founding the South American Christian Theological Seminary in Brazil 27 years ago, for nurturing many people who love the Lord, serve the Lord, being servants of God's family to serve the church and lead people to the Lord. Both myself and the previous principal both graduated from this seminary. In recent years, CIM has sent a short-term mission team to Brazil almost every year to help meager Chinese churches, train the teachers of the school, and lead camps and fellowships for students. The fruit of the Gospel of CIM is everywhere in Brazil. Special thanks to CIM for the intercession for the school over the years, so that we are not alone on this path of educating people and talents, entrusted by God.

In commemorating the 25th anniversary of CIM, I can only offer thanks and intercession to God: May CIM's service in various places be sweeter as it serves, lift up the Lord's name, spread the Gospel widely, glorify God and benefit people."

1. Rev Douglas Wu and others prayed that Sandton Chinese Church in Johannesburg and Rustenburg Church could add two more physical worship services in July, to be held on the second and fourth Sundays. Pray for God to fulfill the plans.
2. Please pray unceasingly for Rev Wu in preparing sermons and Bible study classes, and for Whitney in preparing children's teaching materials, to receive God's grace on them.
3. Rev Wu and the others as they prayed that they would use the Intimacy Journey course to meet and invite new friends, and ask the Lord to reveal His will, so that Douglas and Whitney could familiarize themselves with the use of this course and be able to use it for the Lord.
4. The COVID situation in South Africa has eased a lot. Minister Alex Ko hope that they can organize to go out with brothers and sisters to spread the gospel. They also ask the Lord to give everyone courage and strength to work in the hearts of friends in the Gospel.
5. Minister Ko and others plan to launch a believer edification class at PECCC in the second half of the year, and ask the Lord to give them wisdom to arrange and prepare teaching materials.
6. Alex and Nicole's daughter, Issaca, suffered from severe side effects after her second recovery from COVID. The doctor tried to find a way to relieve her, but it might take a while. Please pray that the Lord will take special care of Issaca's body and mind.
7. For the Chinese church in Bolivia to return to in-person worship as soon as possible, and for God to provide a pastor to shepherd the church.
8. Thankful for the first anniversary of the Belen Chinese Christian Church, and for God to bring more Chinese Christians come to the church to worship God.
9. For the CIM team that will come to Brazil for a STM trip in September.
10. Continue to pray for peace in Ukraine. Though much of the fighting has been concentrated on Eastern Ukraine, refugees continue to travel west to flee the country. Our partner, House of Mercy, is working hard to provide for them and also send aid to the rest of the country. A lot of innocent people are still dying everyday and many from the Roma camps have also fled the country.
11. Pray for guidance and discernment as to when is the best time to start sending STM teams safely overseas again.
12. Pray for the pastors and teachers that CIM Canada support in Ghana. Inflation is currently very high as the cost of living including petrol, food, power, have increased significantly and many are struggling to get by financially.
13. **Pray for the recruiting effort underway to fill job vacancies in CIM for a Director of Ministry to oversee STM and daily operations**, and an Executive Director successor. If you know of anyone who is interested and qualifies, please contact us.
14. Pray that God will move more brothers and sisters to join the ministry so God's kingdom would be more prosperous. Pray for God's abundant provision for all the financial needs of CIM.
