

Douglas Wu Family Prayer Letter

01 June, 2016

Luke 10:1-2 After this the Lord appointed seventy others, and sent them on ahead of him, two by two, into every town and place where he himself was about to come. 2 And he said to them, “The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few; pray therefore the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest.” Luke 10:17 “The seventy returned with joy, saying, “Lord, even the demons are subject to us in your name!”

Lin called us one day and told us that his wife, AiChu, was demon possessed. Sometimes her voice and facial expression would change strangely. After we listened to his descriptions, Whitney and I rushed to his shop right away and hoped to pray for her. When we got there, she seemed fine besides feeling fatigue and looking pale. Lin called us again the next morning. He said that his wife suffered from possession at least half of the night. We asked them what might be the cause, they told us the following story: After Aichu’s uncle died in Fuqing, her mom was the only Christian in the family, so family members often ridiculed her and cursed her death. They said, no one will take care of her in her old age, and she won’t have a proper burial after she dies. Their vicious words made her very depressed. She even posted what they said on WeChat for AiChu to read. Therefore, our first move was to delete the posts from WeChat, we then prayed for her deliverance. At the same night, Lin telephoned us that she was still disturbed by the demon! So we asked PFECCC, churches in San Jose, and PECCC’s brothers and sisters to pray for her. Our action plan was to fast individually during lunch time on Thursday, then all of us would flock in her home in the evening for the ultimate showdown! Minister Sit reminded us to look for unclean object. We found a small gold charm in her jewelry collection. The gourd design, given by a friend of hers, had two idols in it. They were small and intricate. We discovered them through a magnifying glass. So in Jesus’ name, we smashed the object and ceremonially cleansed each room through prayers. Brothers and sisters also laid hands on AiChu and plead for deliverance. Alleluia! Praise the Lord! Lin testified that Jesus had casted out the demon, and she is free.

Deuteronomy 17 “You shall not pervert the justice due to the sojourner or to the fatherless, or take a widow’s garment in pledge; but you shall remember that you were a

slave in Egypt and the Lord your God redeemed you from there; therefore I command you to do this. “

BiJin Chen (whose husband was seriously injured during a robbery in 2007 and died later) came back from Mozambique for her daughter’s new passport. Knowing the daughter still lives in Fuzhou, China, the immigration officer insisted that the applicant must be present in person to apply! Immigration Office in Akasia said the same thing. Knowing this demon is bigger than the previous one, we had to rely on the Lord to overcome the obstacles. The Lord listened to ours prayers and lead BiJin to the immigration office in Centurion. That’s where she got her daughter’s visa. Sister Huang has been in South Africa for three years. Before she left the country last year, she sold her car to a non-Christian Chinese. Through a special means, the buyer is forcing her to buy back the car with 10,000 Rand extra charge. Because she is not in South Africa, she asked me to oversee the transaction. However, the buyer had altered auto’s weight to a truck’s. The officials at the motor vehicle department are even worse. Without God’s help she would never be able to finish the transaction successfully.

Luke 10:18-20 “ And he said to them, “I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven. Behold, I have given you authority to tread upon serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy; and nothing shall hurt you. Nevertheless do not rejoice in this, that the spirits are subject to you; but rejoice that your names are written in heaven.”


