Matthew 6:33 “*But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.*” God has given me this verse, through the 2016 gospel camp “Love in the Storm, Heaven in my Home” by Living Hope Community Church (LHCC) short term mission team from Silicon Valley, as my goal and vision in 2017.

It was a very special short term mission team. One Brother had to return to the US on the sixth day because he came solely for this Christmas gospel camp. Another member was drafted and came to South Africa just after returning to US from finishing another short term mission elsewhere. And I heard yet another member was designated to serve in this short term mission! They started to serve in worship the day they got off the plane, and didn't have any rest until the tenth day when they departed South Africa. During this time two members of the short term mission team had gotten sick! From their attitude of serving the Lord with all their energy, my wife and I had a deeper understanding of the importance in the order of *first seek His kingdom and His righteousness!* Furthermore, we felt the encouragement the short term mission team had brought to the Christians in South Africa. Yet even more precious was the appreciation of the verse for my wife and I on the importance of “*seek first his kingdom and his righteousness*” in the work to spread the gospel.

I remember in my seminary’s Practical Hermeneutics class we had discussed the meaning of the phrase “**kingdom of God**”. There are four interpretations of this phrase in the New Testament. 1. Luke 17:21 “*Nor will people say ‘Here it is’ or ‘There it is’ because **the kingdom of God is within you.***” Here it refers to the sovereignty of kingdom of God. In v20 Jesus said kingdom of God is not visible, instead it is supreme and not limited to the third or fourth dimensions in space! Its infinite sovereignty is over our minds and thoughts. We are God’s children and that exceeds the sovereignties of worldly governments of South Africa, United States, and China. Furthermore, the phrase “***The kingdom of God is within you***” is for everyone to believe and accept Jesus into their hearts. Such is the commission of evangelism, and it’s especially the goal of all short term missions. There was a Papa Lee in the gospel camp this time and he sincerely told me if he were the Chairman of China, he would use all his power to have everyone in China accept Jesus into their hearts.

2. Matthew 12:28 “*But if I drive out demons by the Spirit of God, then **the kingdom of God has come upon you.***” Here it refers to the manifestation of the sovereignty of kingdom of God through His son. Although there was no service to cast out demons by this short term mission team, but clearly it brought up the challenge of the South African Brothers and Sisters of serving both Mammon and God. Through the short term mission team, a strong calling was made to Brothers and Sisters to close their shops for three days so they can attend the gospel camp. From this we saw clearly **the kingdom of God** has come upon us. This time a couple and two Brothers actually closed their shops and attended the gospel camp, and many Sisters were also cured of their sickness.

3. Matthew 5:3 “*Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the **kingdom of heaven.***” God’s promise or bestowment is mentioned here. Rewards are mentioned in the Beatitudes,

meaning Christians can rule along with Christ. My wife and I once again observed the short term mission team’s attitude of humbled to learn in the evangelical ministry, and that led our family back to experience the first love from Jesus. Amid all the busy work of serving in those couple days, we really had the heavenly peace and joy within us.

4. II Peter 1:11 “*and you will receive a rich welcome into the eternal kingdom of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.*” Here it refers to entering the kingdom of God in the future, which would be in the new heaven and earth.

When we immediately drove to look for a signal. We thanked the Lord that there were no bandits to disturb us at the place where we parked, and there was good cell phone signal so we had a smooth and peaceful worship. When we drove back to the church the electricity was restored.
