How to Have Strength in the Shadow of Death

The world has been in chaos recently, and the plague has lasted for a long time. The number of infections worldwide has exceeded 23 million, and the death toll has exceeded 800,000. Many have been shrouded in the shadow of death. Recently, many things have reminded us of the signs of the end. I am not sure whether today is the end of the world, but I can be sure that those signs are gradually being fulfilled.

The book of Revelation predicts that the world will not repeat the cycle, but go to an end. The events of the end of the world are recorded in Revelation 5:1-2, "Then I saw in the right hand of him who sat on the throne a scroll with writing on both sides and sealed with seven seals. And I saw a mighty angel proclaiming in a loud voice, 'Who is worthy to break the seals and open the scroll?'" As soon as this book is opened, the end of the world begins, and God's plan has reached its final stage. God will end this sinful world and start a new heaven and new earth.

This scroll of the doomsday event is sealed by seven seals, and when the time of the **and the time arrives**, it will be opened by the "Lamb" - our Savior. There are four seals in the first part of the seven seals (Rev 6: 1-8). When these four seals are revealed, four knights will appear. These knights on four horses in white, red, black, and gray symbolize the first batch of disasters at the end of the world: battles among nations and civil wars among people; famines everywhere; coupled with large-scale attacks by plagues and wild animals; a quarter of the world's population suddenly died. After the fifth seal was unveiled (Rev 6:9-10), "I saw under the altar the souls of those who had been slain because of the word of God and the testimony they had maintained. They called out in a loud voice, 'How long, Sovereign Lord, holy and true, until you judge the inhabitants of the earth and avenge our blood?"

These fearful omens sound really worrying. Threatened by the virus while sitting at home, there is also the danger of life as a witness to the Lord. In the face of these disasters approaching the end of the world, everyone will feel pessimistic about the prospects. In the midst of disasters, how can we **still be spirited as we face life each day**? Thank God, the book of Revelation **predicts** the great worship in heaven before the seven seals are opened. It turns out that before the catastrophe, this **great worship in heaven** is the source of our strength.

The fifth chapter of Revelation records: God sits on the great throne in the sky, the spirit body in the sky: "the four living creatures and the twenty-four elders are around the throne, each holding a harp and a golden censer filled with the prayers of the saints, prostrate before the Lamb, sing a new song: 'You were slain, and you bought people from all tribes, peoples, and nations with your own blood, and called them to God, and called them a nation, to be a priest to God, on earth In charge of the kingship.'"

There are "many angels, numbering thousands upon thousands, and ten thousand times ten thousand of angels" on the peripheral... "in a loud voice they were saying: "Worthy is the Lamb, who was slain, to receive power and wealth and wisdom and strength and honor and glory and praise!"

On the peripheral, "every creature in heaven and on earth and under the earth and on the sea, and all that is in them, saying: 'To him who sits on the throne and to the Lamb be praise and honor and glory and power, for ever and ever!"

Just now I said that in the face of these catastrophes approaching the end of the world, everyone will be pessimistic. But under the influence of heaven's super greatness, majestic glory, and endless praise, we should no longer have fear.

In worship, we have the faith, knowing God is in control of all.
