## “Come and See What the Lord Has Done”

There's a common gospel song sung across churches in Ghana. It's a simple song comprised of only one sentence of proclamation, "Come and See what the Lord has done!" Our family had the chance to share this proclamation to many church congregations in Canada during our home assignment in 2025. In John 4, Scripture narrates a personal encounter between a Samaritan woman and the living God. The woman left the very thing she went to the well to do to return to her community, where she was socially isolated to proclaim, "*Come and see a man who told me everything I ever did. Could this be the Messiah?*" (John 4:29).

As Christ followers, it is this personal encounter with the living God that changes everything for us. Our salvation and right-standing with a Holy God, our perspective in our earthly lives and the ways we choose to live out Christ's love. By God's grace, I have experienced the power of a personal relationship with God that impacted my life in ways I could not have anticipated. My journey to Ghana started with my first short term missions trip with CIM Canada in 2009. In God's perfect timing, I moved to Ghana as a full-time international ministry worker in January of 2020. My husband Enoch and I were married in 2022 and we were blessed with our daughter Lucy in 2023. As a family, our desire is to live with this sense of proclamation to others, "Come and see what the Lord has done!"

Last Easter, we heard the testimony of a man who was once a traditional idol worshipper. This man was sick for a long time and he sought healing unsuccessfully in numerous ways. Someone from his village advised him to seek the pastor in a neighboring community for prayer. Having exhausted all other options in hopes of healing, the man met with Pastor Caleb in Gmanejere. Pastor Caleb prayed for healing for this man in Jesus' name. Not only did he receive physical healing, but also spiritual healing on that day. Together, they burned all of the man's idols as an act of obedience to his newfound trust in Christ alone. Two weeks later, on Easter Sunday, this man came forward with his testimony echoing the same sentiment, "Come and see what the Lord has done!"

There are many faithful servants like Pastor Caleb who work sacrificially for the sake of the Gospel and furthering God's kingdom in Ghana. By God's grace, we were able to work together to complete the roofing construction of their new church structure in February, 2026. We thank God for His mighty work in both the seemingly small and big ways we can proclaim His goodness!

Our family has much to give thanks to God for as we look forward to welcoming our second baby in July! We appreciate your prayer support as we navigate a new season of our family life, as well as the ongoing ministry of the local church pastors in Ghana.
