## Short Term Mission to Belém (Northern Brazil) Briefing June 4-14, 2026

In June of this year, Rev. Jorge Loo and his wife, along with a mother and son, Sister Zhang Chaoling and her son Dr. Xie Deyao, went on a short-term mission trip to Belém in northern Brazil. In addition to the four of us, there was also a 16-person medical mission team with Dr. Lin Zhengyi, a Canadian, making a total of 20 people. Among these 20 people, there were 3 Western medicine practitioners, 3 dentists, 4 dental technicians, 1 pharmacist, 1 acupuncturist, and 2 pastors.

We provided medical services at four different locations. Since most of the Chinese patients run shops in downtown Belém, and they were all busy with their businesses, we chose weekends for the Chinese and weekdays for the locals. While providing medical care, we also shared the Gospel with the patients as much as possible. This time, there were many more Brazilian patients than Chinese patients compared to last year. We speculated that this was likely because the locations were moved to more distant areas. Even so, some patients who came last year returned this year. In particular, there was Mrs. Lin, a Taiwanese Buddhist. Three years ago, when we visited her shop and gave her Gospel pamphlets, she told us she didn't need to come anymore. However, she came for a visit last year and felt much better; this year she came again, bringing her son and daughter-in-law as well. She also brought some Taiwanese food for us, just like last year. Clearly, her attitude towards us was much friendlier. Mrs. Loo and Sister Zhang Chaoling shared the Gospel with her this time. Because they could speak Taiwanese, the atmosphere was even more intimate. Their relationship grew closer, and we continued to pray for their family's faith. During the church's free clinic in Brazil, the local pastor told me that some of the patients, after hearing the Gospel, accepted Jesus as their Savior. Praise the Lord!

I encouraged one another with Colossians 1:28-29: *"He is the one we proclaim, admonishing and teaching everyone with all wisdom, so that we may present everyone fully mature in Christ. To this end I strenuously contend with all the energy Christ so powerfully works in me."* And then Colossians 1:29: *"To this end I strenuously contend with all the energy Christ so powerfully works in me."* May the Lord receive all the glory!

7. Continue to pray for CIM Canada's ministry partners in Ukraine, Togo and Ghana. Pray especially for peace in Ukraine and for the global economy that is greatly affecting all countries and impacting the livelihoods of many.
8. Please pray earnestly for healing for CIM Canada's executive director, Rev. Isaac Quan who has been hospitalized for some time now. His medical team is hoping to start chemotherapy soon.
